Alejandro Dávalos is a career member of the Ecuadorian Foreign Service with the rank of Minister. He is currently serving as Deputy Permanent Representative at the Permanent Mission of Ecuador to the United Nations in Geneva (2018-present).

Mr. Dávalos served as Vice Minister of Foreign Trade (Negotiations, Integration, and Trade Remedies), Undersecretary of Trade Negotiations and Economic Integration at the Ministry of Foreign Trade, and Chief Negotiator for Free Trade Agreements (2015-2017).

During his service abroad, Mr. Dávalos held the position of Attaché for Political and Legal Affairs at the Embassy of Ecuador to the United States of America (1998 – 2003). He was later appointed as Director of Ecuador's Trade and Investment Office in Peru (2006 – 2015).

Mr. Dávalos has 25 years of experience in bilateral and multilateral relations, dealing with issues related to foreign policy and international negotiations, human rights, migration, cooperation and development, regional integration and trade negotiations, trade intelligence and market access, and promotion of exports and foreign investment.

Mr. Dávalos studied at the Pontifical Catholic University of Ecuador, obtaining a Bachelor's Degree in Law. Later, he obtained a Graduate Certificate in Strategic Public Policy Planning from FLACSO and graduated from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Diplomatic Academy.

He has completed various specialized courses on trade, economics, policymaking, and international relations in Ecuador, Mexico, United States of America, China, Uruguay, and Peru.

Additionally, Mr. Dávalos has been invited by business associations, chambers of commerce, and universities to speak about foreign trade, economic integration, export promotion and foreign investment.
