SUMMARY

Iris Bodendorf became Head of Division for Export Controls: General Affairs, Dual Use Goods at the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy in 2019, where she is, inter alia, in charge of the EU Anti-Torture Regulation. Her office oversees the German license application process for export of listed items as well as the German contribution to the development and implementation of the EU Anti Torture Regulation.

Prior to that she was Deputy Head of Division for Export Control, Defense Goods where she participated in working groups and plenary meetings of the Arms Trade Treaty. Before joining the Foreign Trade division of the Ministry, she held positions with the United Nations Secretariat in New York/USA and Santiago/Chile, the Directorate General for European Policy in the Federal Ministry of Finance in Berlin and the Permanent Mission of Germany to the EU in Brussels.

She studied economics, political science and law in Germany and the United States and holds a Master in International Relations from Yale University.
